I read of a preacher who followed the ministry of a well-known pastor and author, someone who had greatly influenced his own life and ministry. At the scheduled time, he knocked on the door and was welcomed into the house. Passing through the very sparsely furnished home, he was taken to the pastor's study. The visitor replied, "Oh, I'm just passing through." He said, "Well, so am I." C. S.
